As part of Ohio House of Representatives Bill 512 (HB 512) passed this last summer, passed by the Ohio General Assembly, was signed by Governor John Kasich, and went into effect September 9, 2016, Northern Ohio Rural Water is required to identify and map areas of the water system known or are likely to contain lead service lines and identify characteristics of buildings (homes) served by the system that may contain lead piping, solder or fixtures.
